Jn 11:25 “I am the resurrection and the life. Anyone who believes in me will live.”

Jn 14:1 - “Do not let your heart be troubled. Believe in God, believe also in me.”

Jn 15:9 “As the Father has loved me so have I loved you, now remain in my love.”

Jn 20:21 “Peace be with you as the father has sent me I send you.”
